Academics:

Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of endeavour of all educators and academic institutions an important measure of this pursuit is how the institution has performed, the most important of which is the annual ,school ending examination conducted by the CBSE

We are proud to report that the students of class X and XII, who appeared for Secondary & Sr. Sec. School Examination held by CBSE for session 202I-22, have brought laurels to school by their excellent results. We achieved 100% results in CBSE class-X & class-XII examination. In class-X Pradum Tiwari topped the school with 95 % score and 75 % students passed with first division. In class –XII we bagged maximum top positions at District level in commerce stream Anjani Sharma bagged the first position with 95 % marks , Simranjit Kaur was second topper with 94.3 % marks and Harsh Punj was third topper with 93.4 %. In Medical & Non-Medical Sukhmandeep Kaur & Mehak topped highest score respectively. We congratulate these students for their excellent performance & extend warmed wishes for their bright future.

Moving forward, towards the activities conducted by school during the whole academic year.

- 1 Deepika got Rs. 10,000/- cash prize each in INSPIRE Award Scheme.Her model "Smart dustbin "was selected for the project.
- 2 In "International Hindi Olympiad " total 88 students participated from class 1st to 12th and Deepika from class X was honoured with "Rashtria Hindi Pratibha Samman" by Hindi Vikash Sansthan Delhi.9 students got gold medals and 3 students got silver medal and 2 students got bronze medal in international Hindi Olympiad.
- 3 In the month of November Science Exhibition was organised where the students came forward with new creative ideas and models on topics given separately for every class. Many new concepts were showcased by the students .
- 3 Science Olympiad, English Olympiad and Maths Olympiad were conducted in this year more than 80 students participate in exam.
- 4 NASA Olympiad was conducted where out of 40 students 30 students got excellence certificate and got selected for level -2.

From Sports:

- 6. I feel happy to share that total number of 128 students of M.I.A DAV Schoolhave participated in basketball and athletic meets held and national level. We have four times participated in National CBSE, Cluster Basketball held at Chennai (2011), Jaipur(2012), Agra(2013) and Andhra Pradesh (2014)
- 7. Our basketball team was runner up in CBSE basketball Cluster(2017, Hamirpur) and CBSE basketball Cluster held at Fatehabad in 2019.
- 8 In academics session 2022-23, three students of our school were selected in National CBSE Cluster 2022. Palak Choudhary, Ankita Sharma, and Deepika Rani.
- 9. In CBSE Cluster held at DAV PUBLIC SCHOOL, CHEEKA, kaithal Haryana our one student Palak Choudhary got God medal in long jump. Ankita Sharma and Deepika Rani won Silver medal in high jump. Three students (Sohit kumar, Mohit Sigh and Ansh Sharma) won Bronze medal in 800m,3000m race and triple jump.

- 6 The Sports department organized a series of Inter House indoors and outdoors tournaments for the games of basketball, kho- Kho, kabaddi, badminton throughout the year. There has been an increase in participation and achievements in , Athletics, basketball, kho-kho, outside the school areas, such as inter school, state level and national level events.
- 7 . In interschool sports meat our school has bagged his position by winning four gold medals, four silver medal and three bronze in athletics. Our kho Kho teams both boys and girls were winner in interschool competition.
